

{Extra Strength} Free DIY Holiday Photo Card

How to:

1. Print the 5x7 card onto cardstock. (page 2 is the printable card)
2. Print and cut out one photo backing sheet per card. (page 3 has the backing sheets)
3. Cut out the entire 5x7 card along the gray cut lines as marked.
4. Then carefully cut out the framed portion on the front of the card. Dotted lines have been provided for you, to give a



guide. You can follow the dotted lines **OR use fine-tip scissors to cut out the frame exactly along the lines of the graphics.** This is detailed work, but the end result will be FABULOUS.

5. Place your favorite holiday 4x6 photo into the frame you've just created and use double-stick tape or scrapbook-safe glue "dots" to secure to the inside front cover of the card.

6. Place the BACKING piece over the back of your 4x6 photo and use double-stick tape or scrapbook-safe glue "dots" to secure. This will keep your photo extra secure and make sure it stays in place when mailed.

7. Write your holiday message on the inside of your card.

8. And super-GLAM photo card... done!

Repeat as many times as you like to create your holiday photo cards.

A few notes:

You can get white cardstock in reams of 500 at Walmart or office supply stores.
